BYE - LAW No 5

Education Programme Bye Law

1. **Introduction**

This Bye-Law is made by the Council of Financial Planning Standards Board Ireland Limited (the "Council" and "FPSB Ireland") pursuant to article 32 of the articles of association of FPSB Ireland on 4th November 2010.

2. **Education Programme**

Candidates for CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER professional certification examination must hold the Qualified Financial Adviser (QFA) designation and complete the prescribed education programme (being an FPSB Ireland registered programme provided by a registered Education Provider as set out in schedule 1).
